1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 18-1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/18-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 18-1)
- 7 Sec. 18-1. Robbery.
- 8 (a) A person commits robbery when he or she takes property,
- 9 except a motor vehicle covered by Section 18-3 or 18-4, from
- 10 the person or presence of another by the use of force or by
- 11 threatening the imminent use of force.
- 12 (b) Sentence.
- Robbery is a Class 2 felony. However, if the victim is 60
- 14 years of age or over or is a physically handicapped person, or
- if the robbery is committed in a school or place of worship or
- at an automatic teller machine or for the purpose of acquiring
- the automatic teller machine card or identification number of
- 18 <u>another</u>, robbery is a Class 1 felony.
