(a) A person commits robbery when he or she takes property, 8 except a motor vehicle covered by Section 18-3 or 18-4, from 9 the person or presence of another by the use of force or by 10 threatening the imminent use of force. 11 (b) Sentence. 12 Robbery is a Class 2 felony. However, if the victim is 60 13 years of age or over or is a physically handicapped person, or 14 15 if the robbery is committed in a school or place of worship or at an automatic teller machine or for the purpose of acquiring 16 17 the automatic teller machine card or identification number of 18 another, robbery is a Class 1 felony.
