AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-25012 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-25012) (from Ch. 34, par. 5-25012)

7 Sec. 5-25012. Board of health. Except in those cases where a board of 10 or 12 members is provided for as authorized in 8 this Section, each county health department shall be managed by 9 a board of health consisting of 8 members appointed by the 10 president or chairman of the county board, with the approval of 11 the county board, for a 3 year term, except that of the first 12 appointees 2 shall serve for one year, 2 for 2 years, 3 for 3 13 14 years and the term of the member appointed from the county 15 board, as provided in this Section, shall be one year and shall continue until reappointment or until a successor is appointed. 16 17 Each board of health which has 8 members, may have one 18 additional member appointed by the president or chairman of the 19 county board, with the approval of the county board. The additional member shall first be appointed within 90 days after 20 the effective date of this amendatory Act for a term ending 21 22 July 1, 2002.

23 county health department in a The county having a population of 200,000 or more may, if the county board, by 24 25 resolution, so provides, be managed by a board of health 26 consisting of 12 members appointed by the president or chairman of the county board, with the approval of the county board, for 27 28 a 3 year term, except that of the first appointees 3 shall 29 serve for one year, 4 for 2 years, 4 for 3 years and the term of 30 the member appointed from the county board, as provided in this one year and shall continue until 31 Section, shall be reappointment or until a successor is appointed. In counties 32

with a population of 200,000 or more which have a board of health of 8 members, the county board may, by resolution, increase the size of the board of health to 12 members, in which case the 4 members added shall be appointed, as of the next anniversary of the present appointments, 2 for terms of 3 years, one for 2 years and one for one year.

The county board in counties with a population of more than 7 8 100,000 but less than 3,000,000 inhabitants and contiguous to 9 any county with a metropolitan area with more than 1,000,000 10 inhabitants, may establish compensation for the board of 11 health, as remuneration for their services as members of the 12 board of health. Monthly compensation shall not exceed \$200 except in the case of the president of the board of health 13 whose monthly compensation shall not exceed \$400. 14

When a county board of health consisting of 8 members 15 16 assumes the responsibilities of a municipal department of 17 public health, and both the county board and the city council adopt resolutions or ordinances to that effect, the county 18 board may, by resolution or ordinance, increase the membership 19 20 of the county board of health to 10 members. The additional 2 members shall initially be appointed by the mayor of the 21 municipality, with the approval of the city council, each such 22 23 member to serve for a term of 2 years; thereafter the successors shall be appointed by the president or chairman of 24 the county board, with the approval of the county board, for 25 te<u>rms of 2 years.</u> 26

27 Each multiple-county health department shall be managed by 28 a board of health consisting of 4 members appointed from each county by the president or chairman of the county board with 29 30 the approval of the county board for a 3 year term, except that 31 of the first appointees from each county one shall serve for 32 one year, one for 2 years, one for 3 years and the term of the member appointed from the county board of each member county, 33 as hereinafter provided, shall be one year and shall continue 34 until reappointment or until a successor is appointed. 35

The term of office of original appointees shall begin on

1 July 1 following their appointment, and the term of all members 2 shall continue until their successors are appointed. All 3 members shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for actual necessary expenses incurred in the performance of 4 5 their duties. At least 2 members of each county board of health shall be physicians licensed in Illinois to practice medicine 6 in all of its branches and at least one member shall be a 7 8 dentist licensed in Illinois. In counties with a population 9 under 500,000, one member shall be chosen from the county board 10 or the board of county commissioners as the case may be. In 11 counties with a population over 500,000, two members shall be 12 chosen from the county board or the board of county 13 commissioners as the case may be. At least one member from each county on each multiple-county board of health shall be a 14 15 physician licensed in Illinois to practice medicine in all of 16 its branches, one member from each county on each 17 multiple-county board of health shall be chosen from the county board or the board of county commissioners, as the case may be, 18 19 and at least one member of the board of health shall be a 20 dentist licensed in Illinois. Whenever possible, at least one member shall have experience in the field of mental health. All 21 22 members shall be chosen for their special fitness for 23 membership on the board.

Any member may be removed for misconduct or neglect of duty by the chairman or president of the county board, with the approval of the county board, of the county which appointed him.

28 Vacancies shall be filled as in the case of appointment for 29 a full term.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the contrary, a county with a population of 240,000 or more inhabitants that does not currently have a county health department may, by resolution of the county board, establish a board of health consisting of the members of such board. 1 chairman of the county board with the approval of the county 2 board for terms of 3 years; except that of the first appointees at least 2 shall serve for 3 years, at least 2 shall serve for 2 3 years and at least one shall serve for one year. At least one 4 5 member of the advisory committee shall be a physician licensed in Illinois to practice medicine in all its branches, at least 6 7 one shall be a dentist licensed in Illinois, and one shall be a nurse licensed in Illinois. All members shall be chosen for 8 their special fitness for membership on the advisory committee. 9

All members of a board established under this Section must be residents of the county, except that a member who is required to be a physician, dentist, or nurse may reside outside the county if no physician, dentist, or nurse, as applicable, who resides in the county is willing and able to serve.
