SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Counties Code. Authorizes counties to license hawkers, peddlers, itinerant merchants, and transient vendors. Authorizes counties to impose a license fee and adopt rules concerning application and eligibility requirements for a license.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section 5-1058 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1058) (from Ch. 34, par. 5-1058)
- 7 Sec. 5-1058. Hawkers, peddlers, itinerant merchants, and transient vendors. A county board may <u>license and</u> regulate, in 8 the manner authorized by this Section hawkers, peddlers, 9 10 itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise in any area not within the corporate limits of a municipality which 11 12 licenses or regulates hawkers, peddlers, itinerant merchants, and transient vendors of merchandise. The county board may 13 14 require that any such person register his name and the name of 15 any firm he represents with the county clerk and may make reasonable restrictions of the hours during which he may engage 16 17 in door - to - door solicitation. The board may shall not require a <u>license</u> fee from such persons <u>and adopt rules</u> 18 19 concerning application and eligibility requirements for a 20 license or make regulations other than those authorized by this 21 Section. The provisions of this Section do not apply to any county which is a home rule unit, which may license and 22 regulate such persons under its home rule powers. 23
