A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

ARTICLE 1

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
6 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the
7 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent
8 expenses:

25 Section 10. The sum of \$354,259,800, or so much thereof
26 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
27 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for
28 payment of Monetary Award Program grant awards to students

1 eligible to receive such awards, as provided by law.

2 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
4 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student
5 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

6 Grants and Scholarships

7 For payment of matching grants to Illinois
8 institutions to supplement scholarship
9 programs, as provided by law950,000

10 For the payment of scholarships to students
11 who are children of policemen or firemen
12 killed in the line of duty, or who are
13 dependents of correctional officers killed
14 or permanently disabled in the line of
15 duty, as provided by law470,000

16 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
17 Naval Militia Scholarships at
18 State-controlled universities and public
19 community colleges in Illinois to students
20 eligible to receive such awards, as
21 provided by law4,480,000

22 For payment of military Veterans' scholarships
23 at State-controlled universities and at
24 public community colleges for students
25 eligible, as provided by law19,250,000

26 For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships3,100,000

27 For payment of Illinois Scholars Scholarships3,020,000

28 For payment of Illinois Incentive for Access
29 grants, as provided by law8,200,000

30 For college savings bond grants to
31 students who are eligible to
32 receive such awards650,000

33 Total \$40,120,000

1 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 3 Illinois National Guard Grant Fund to the Illinois Student
 4 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

5 Grants and Scholarships

6 For payment of Illinois National Guard
 7 Naval Militia Scholarships
 8 at State-controlled universities
 9 and public community colleges in
 10 Illinois to students eligible to
 11 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

12 Section 25. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 14 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the
 15 Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

16 Section 30. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 18 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
 19 scholarships and living expenses grants to increase the
 20 number of forensic science students who are pursuing a
 21 program to become qualified to perform DNA testing at
 22 Illinois State Police forensic science facilities.

 24 Section 35. The sum of \$1,350,000, or so much thereof as
 25 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 26 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
 27 scholarships and living expenses grants for nursing education
 28 students who are pursuing their Master's degree to become
 29 nurse faculty.

1 Section 40. The following named amount, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 3 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 4 for the following purpose:

5 Grants and Scholarships
 6 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher
 7 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law4,100,000

8 Section 45. The following named amount, or so much
 9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 10 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 11 Commission for the following purpose:

12 To support outreach, research, and
 13 training activities70,000

14 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much
 15 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 16 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
 17 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
 18 purpose:

19 Grants and Scholarships
 20 For payment of scholarships for the
 21 Optometric Education Scholarship
 22 Program, as provided by law50,000

23 Section 55. The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof
 24 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 25 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
 26 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
 27 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection
 28 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
 29 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
 30 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default
 31 Aversion Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for

1 other distributions as necessary and provided for under the
2 Federal Higher Education Act.

3 Section 60. The sum of \$21,334,400, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
5 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
6 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
7 of collection agency fees associated with collection
8 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
9 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
10 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

11 Section 65. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
13 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
14 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
15 Maintenance.

16 Section 70. The sum of \$300,000, or so much of that
17 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
18 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
19 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
20 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
21 Act of 1986.

22 Section 75. The following named amount, or so much
23 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
24 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
25 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

26 For payment of Robert C. Byrd
27 Honors Scholarships1,800,000

28 Section 80. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
29 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student

1 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
2 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
3 Program, as provided by law.

4 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
6 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

8 For transferring repayment funds collected
9 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
10 Program to the U.S. Treasury400,000

11 Section 90. The following named amount, or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
13 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the
14 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
15 purpose:

16 For payment of scholarships for the
17 Illinois Future Teacher Corps
18 Scholarship Program as provided by law57,000
19 For payment for grants to the Golden Apple
Foundation for Excellence in Teaching3,000

20 Section 95. The following named amount, or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
22 Student Incentive Trust Fund for the Federal Leveraging
23 Educational Assistance and the Supplemental Leveraging
24 Educational Assistance Programs to the Illinois Student
25 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

26 Grants
27 For payment of Monetary Award Program grants to
28 full-time and part-time students eligible
29 to receive such grants, as provided by law3,700,000

1 Section 100. The sum of \$2,128,100, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student Loan
3 Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
4 for costs and expenses related to or in support of a higher
5 education shared services center.

7 Section 105. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for a
10 grant to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University
11 for the Financial Assistance Outreach Center.

12 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
13 2006.
