17 WHEREAS, He served McHenry as an alderman from the 3rd Ward 18 for 29 years; he was a member of International Brotherhood of 19 Electrical Workers Local 117, American Legion Post 491, Order 20 of the Moose Lodge 691, St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic 21 Church in McHenry, Catholic Order of Foresters No. 594, and the 22 Legion of Honor; and

23 WHEREAS, He enjoyed family time with his children and 24 grandchildren, golfing, fishing, and taking long walks around 25 town; he will be best remembered for being a good friend to 26 many and for helping people with his "fix-it" skills; and
