2 WHEREAS, Joseph H. Haley, the founder and executive 3 director of Jackie Robinson West Little League in Chicago, 4 passed away on June 13, 2005 at the age of 71; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Haley, a native of Enoch, Louisiana, earned an 6 Associate of Arts degree from Compton College of California, a 7 Bachelor of Arts degree from Grambling State University, and a 8 Master of Arts degree from DePaul University; he served as 9 Assistant Principal at Marcus Garvey Elementary School; and

10 league with just five teams, WHEREAS, From a Jackie 11 Robinson West Little League has grown to more than 1,000 players on 36 teams; the league has instilled the values of 12 13 good citizenship, perseverance, team effort, sportsmanship, 14 and self-discipline in generations of young people; Mr. Haley wanted the children in his league to get a good education and 15 16 taught them that school was more important than baseball; one 17 of his proudest accomplishments was the completion of Jackie Robinson Stadium at 107th and Morgan; and 18
