22 WHEREAS, Mr. Irvin was a loyal member at Beautiful Gate 23 Temple COGIC in Zion for some years, where he served as the 24 President of the Benevolent Fund; he loved life, golfing, 25 Sunday school, and riding his Honda Gold Wing; and
