Olive Church in 23 Orlando, Florida; he went on to pursue a Masters of Business 24 Administration Degree, graduating from the St. Louis Campus of 25 Webster College; he then began work on his doctorate degree and 26 had a year and a half left to complete his studies; and

27 WHEREAS, He was employed at the Sun Trust Bank of Orlando, 28 Florida, where he made many friends; he was a fun-loving person 29 that enjoyed making people laugh; and
