Amends the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that a person who is convicted of any felony relating to, arising out of, or in connection with his or her service as a participating member of any retirement system or pension fund may not receive any benefits provided in the Code, including any benefit for service not related to the felony conviction. Repeals various similar provisions of the Illinois Pension Code that were restricted in application to individual Articles. Effective immediately.

 vested right acquired before the effective date of this

 - All participants entering service after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly are deemed to have consented to the provisions of this Section as a condition of participation in a retirement system or pension
