Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 5 Sections 3-664, 3-665, and 3-666 as follows:

7 Sec. 3-664. Iraq Campaign license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Iraq Campaign license plates to residents of Illinois who 11 12 have earned the Iraq Campaign Medal from the United States Armed Forces. The special Iraq Campaign plates issued under 13 14 this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 15 16 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 17 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 19 Code.

20 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 21 22 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 23

Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to
 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of

6 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a <u>\$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate</u> 7 registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the 8 9 Illinois Military Family Relief Fund and \$15 shall be deposited 10 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be 11 used by the Secretary to help defray the administrative 12 processing costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be 13 14 charged. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Illinois Military Family Relief Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the 15 16 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 6 7 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State.
