1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-26 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-26 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-26. Federal Family Opportunity Act.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "the federal Act" means the
 9 federal Family Opportunity Act, enacted as part of the Deficit
- 10 Reduction Act of 2005.
- 11 (b) The Department of Human Services, in conjunction with 12 the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, shall
- implement the Medical Assistance provisions of the federal Act
- 14 <u>as soon as possible after the effective date of this amendatory</u>
- 15 <u>Act of the 95th General Assembly.</u>
- (c) As soon as possible after the effective date of this
- amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, the Department of
- 18 Human Services, in conjunction with the Department of
- 19 Healthcare and Family Services, shall take all necessary and
- 20 appropriate steps to try to secure (i) any available federal
- 21 funds for a demonstration project regarding home and
- 22 community-based alternatives to psychiatric residential
- treatment facilities for children, as authorized by the federal

- Act, and (ii) the location in Illinois of a family-to-family 1
- 2 health information center, as authorized by the federal Act.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 3
- 4 becoming law.
