"A physician or counselor who in good faith provides information and counseling to a minor pursuant to Section 25 is not subject to any type of civil or criminal liability or discipline for unprofessional conduct for any of his or her actions in connection with providing such counseling and information.

Section 50. Right of conscience. No provision of this Act
impairs a physician, counselor, or other healthcare
professional's rights under the Health Care Right of Conscience
Act and the Abortion Performance Refusal Act.".
