1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 408

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 408 on page 1, by
3 replacing lines 4 and 5 with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Sections 5.675 and 6z-69 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.675 new)

7 Sec. 5.675. The Safe Student Driver Initiative Fund.

8 (30 ILCS 105/6z-69 new)

9 Sec. 6z-69. The Safe Student Driver Initiative Fund. The
10 Safe Student Driver Initiative Fund is created as a special
11 fund in the State treasury. The Secretary of State shall,
12 subject to appropriation, use all moneys in the Safe Student
13 Driver Initiative Fund to cover all costs associated with the
14 manufacture, distribution, and administration of Student
15 Driver signs and any other costs associated with the Graduated

1 Licensing Program.

2 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
3 changing Sections 6-107, 6-107.1, and 6-118 as follows:"; and

4 on page 8, below line 9, by inserting the following:

5 "(625 ILCS 5/6-118) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 6-118)
6 Sec. 6-118. Fees.

7 (a) The fee for licenses and permits under this Article is
8 as follows:

26 SPECIAL FEES FOR COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE

1 The fees for commercial driver licenses and permits
2 under Article V shall be as follows:

3 Commercial driver's license:

4 \$6 for the CDLIS/AAMVAnet Fund
5 (Commercial Driver's License Information
6 System/American Association of Motor Vehicle
7 Administrators network Trust Fund);
8 \$20 for the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection Fund;
9 \$10 for the driver's license;
10 and \$24 for the CDL: \$60

11 Renewal commercial driver's license:

12 \$6 for the CDLIS/AAMVAnet Trust Fund;
13 \$20 for the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection Fund;
14 \$10 for the driver's license; and
15 \$24 for the CDL: \$60

16 Commercial driver instruction permit

17 issued to any person holding a valid
18 Illinois driver's license for the
19 purpose of changing to a
20 CDL classification: \$6 for the
21 CDLIS/AAMVAnet Trust Fund;
22 \$20 for the Motor Carrier
23 Safety Inspection Fund; and
24 \$24 for the CDL classification \$50

25 Commercial driver instruction permit

26 issued to any person holding a valid

1 Illinois CDL for the purpose of
 2 making a change in a classification,
 3 endorsement or restriction \$5
 4 CDL duplicate or corrected license \$5

5 In order to ensure the proper implementation of the Uniform
 6 Commercial Driver License Act, Article V of this Chapter, the
 7 Secretary of State is empowered to pro-rate the \$24 fee for the
 8 commercial driver's license proportionate to the expiration
 9 date of the applicant's Illinois driver's license.

10 The fee for any duplicate license or permit shall be waived
 11 for any person age 60 or older who presents the Secretary of
 12 State's office with a police report showing that his license or
 13 permit was stolen.

14 No additional fee shall be charged for a driver's license,
 15 or for a commercial driver's license, when issued to the holder
 16 of an instruction permit for the same classification or type of
 17 license who becomes eligible for such license.

18 (b) Any person whose license or privilege to operate a
 19 motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked under
 20 Section 3-707, any provision of Chapter 6, Chapter 11, or
 21 Section 7-205, 7-303, or 7-702 of the Family Financial
 22 Responsibility Law of this Code, shall in addition to any other
 23 fees required by this Code, pay a reinstatement fee as follows:

24 Suspension under Section 3-707 \$100
 25 Summary suspension under Section 11-501.1 \$250
 26 Other suspension \$70

1 Revocation \$500

2 However, any person whose license or privilege to operate a
3 motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked for a
4 second or subsequent time for a violation of Section 11-501 or
5 11-501.1 of this Code or a similar provision of a local
6 ordinance or a similar out-of-state offense or Section 9-3 of
7 the Criminal Code of 1961 and each suspension or revocation was
8 for a violation of Section 11-501 or 11-501.1 of this Code or a
9 similar provision of a local ordinance or a similar
10 out-of-state offense or Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of
11 1961 shall pay, in addition to any other fees required by this
12 Code, a reinstatement fee as follows:

13 Summary suspension under Section 11-501.1 \$500

14 Revocation \$500

15 (c) All fees collected under the provisions of this Chapter
16 6 shall be paid into the Road Fund in the State Treasury except
17 as follows:

18 1. The following amounts shall be paid into the Driver
19 Education Fund:

20 (A) \$16 of the \$20 or \$22 fee for an original
21 driver's instruction permit;

22 (B) \$5 of the \$10 fee for an original driver's
23 license;

24 (C) \$5 of the \$10 fee for a 4 year renewal driver's
25 license; and

26 (D) \$4 of the \$8 fee for a restricted driving

1 permit.

2 2. \$30 of the \$250 fee for reinstatement of a license
3 summarily suspended under Section 11-501.1 shall be
4 deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention
5 Fund. However, for a person whose license or privilege to
6 operate a motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or
7 revoked for a second or subsequent time for a violation of
8 Section 11-501 or 11-501.1 of this Code or Section 9-3 of
9 the Criminal Code of 1961, \$190 of the \$500 fee for
10 reinstatement of a license summarily suspended under
11 Section 11-501.1, and \$190 of the \$500 fee for
12 reinstatement of a revoked license shall be deposited into
13 the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Fund.

14 3. \$6 of such original or renewal fee for a commercial
15 driver's license and \$6 of the commercial driver
16 instruction permit fee when such permit is issued to any
17 person holding a valid Illinois driver's license, shall be
18 paid into the CDLIS/AAMVAnet Trust Fund.

19 4. \$30 of the \$70 fee for reinstatement of a license
20 suspended under the Family Financial Responsibility Law
21 shall be paid into the Family Responsibility Fund.

22 5. The \$5 fee for each original or renewal M or L
23 endorsement shall be deposited into the Cycle Rider Safety
24 Training Fund.

25 6. \$20 of any original or renewal fee for a commercial
26 driver's license or commercial driver instruction permit

1 shall be paid into the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection
2 Fund.

3 7. The following amounts shall be paid into the General
4 Revenue Fund:

5 (A) \$190 of the \$250 reinstatement fee for a
6 summary suspension under Section 11-501.1;

7 (B) \$40 of the \$70 reinstatement fee for any other
8 suspension provided in subsection (b) of this Section;
9 and

10 (C) \$440 of the \$500 reinstatement fee for a first
11 offense revocation and \$310 of the \$500 reinstatement
12 fee for a second or subsequent revocation.

13 8. \$2 of the \$22 fee for an original driver's
14 instruction permit issued to persons under the age of 18
15 shall be paid into The Safe Student Driver Initiative Fund.
