10 ILCS 5/1-15 new

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a person is not eligible for an elective public office if that person has been convicted of a felony relating to his or her duties in an elective government office.

- 7 <u>Sec. 1-15. Ineligibility of felon for public office.</u>
- 8 (a) A person is not eligible for any public office who has
- 9 been convicted in any court located in the United States of any
- 10 <u>felony relating to his or her duties in an elective government</u>
- office.
- 12 (b) As used in this Section, "public office" means an
- office for which candidates are required to file statements of
- 14 economic interests under the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act.
