## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Appropriation Procedures Act. Provides that a bill making an appropriation may not be considered for final passage by either the House of Representatives or the Senate unless that chamber first adopts, by a record vote of at least two-thirds of the members elected, a motion to consider that bill. Effective immediately.

- 8 by either the House of Representatives or the Senate unless
- 9 that chamber first adopts, by a record vote of at least
- 10 two-thirds of the members elected, a motion to consider that
- 11 bill.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
