

## 95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 HB0499

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

75 ILCS 5/4-3.3

from Ch. 81, par. 4-3.3

Amends the Illinois Local Library Act. Makes the minimum signature requirement for a nominating petition for the office of library board trustee 2% of the number of votes cast at the last election for library trustee or 25, whichever is less (now, 50).

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Local Library Act is amended by changing Section 4-3.3 as follows:

6 (75 ILCS 5/4-3.3) (from Ch. 81, par. 4-3.3)

7 Sec. 4-3.3. Nominations for the position of library trustee including the first board of library trustees shall be by 8 9 petition, signed by at least 50 legal voters residing in the 10 incorporated town or village (except a village under the commission form of government) or township equal in number to 11 at least 2% of the number of votes cast at the most recent 12 election for library trustee or 25, whichever is less, and 13 14 filed with the clerk of such incorporated town, village, or township within the time prescribed by the general election 15 16 law. Such clerk shall certify the candidates for library 17 trustees to the proper election authorities who shall conduct the election in accordance with the general election law. All 18 19 candidates must be residents of the incorporated town, village or township involved. The ballots shall not designate any 20 21 political party, platform or political principle.
