SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/9-254 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Requires an electric utility to refund a customer's electricity bill for the time during electric utility outages at the rate of \$100 per day for an outage lasting between 25 or more hours and 72 or less hours, and at a rate of \$200 per day for an outage lasting more than 72 hours. Effective immediately.

- 7 Sec. 9-254. Customer refunds for utility outages. An
- 8 electric utility must refund a customer's electricity bill for
- 9 the time during electric utility outages as follows:
- 10 (1) A refund of \$100 per day for an electric utility outage
- 11 lasting between 25 or more hours and 72 or less hours.
- 12 (2) A refund of \$200 per day for an electric utility outage
- 13 lasting more than 72 hours.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
