Sec. 4.08. Rural and small town meals program. Subject to appropriation, the Department may establish a program to ensure the availability of congregate or home-delivered meals in communities with populations of under 5,000 that are not located within the large urban counties of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, Madison, McHenry, St. Clair, or Will. The Department may meet the requirements of this Section by entering into contractual agreements with local providers of nutritional services, which may include, but need not be limited to, restaurants, cafes, churches, facilities licensed under the Nursing Home Care Act or the Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act, facilities certified by the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, and senior centers. Support provided shall be in the form of grants. The Department shall request any necessary waivers of federal requirements in order to allow receipt of federal funds for implementing the program.
