1 AN ACT concerning State historic sites.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Historic Preservation Agency Act is amended by adding Section 10.5 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3405/10.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 10.5. State historic sites required to be open. The</u>
- 8 Illinois Historic Preservation Agency must keep the following
- 9 State historic sites open to the public 7 days per week:
- 10 (1) Black Hawk State Historic Site;
- 11 (2) Cahokia Mounds State Historic Site;
- 12 (3) Fort Kaskaskia State Historic Site;
- 13 (4) U.S. Grant Home State Historic Site;
- 14 (5) Lincoln-Herndon Law Office State Historic Site;
- 15 (6) Lincoln Log Cabin State Historic Site;
- 16 (7) Lincoln's New Salem State Historic Site;
- 17 <u>(8) Lincoln's Tomb State Historic Site;</u>
- 18 (9) Pierre Menard Home State Historic Site; and
- 19 <u>(10) Old State Capitol State Historic Site.</u>
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
