Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no 4 later than 60 days following the effective date of this 5 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, any fixed route public transportation services provided by, or under grant or 6 7 purchase of service contracts of, the Suburban Bus Board shall 8 be provided without charge to all senior citizens of the 9 Metropolitan Region aged 65 and older, under such conditions as shall be prescribed by the Suburban Bus Board."; and 10 on page 148, below line 12, by inserting the following: 11 12 "(70 ILCS 3615/3B.14 new) Sec. 3B.14. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no 13 14 later than 60 days following the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, any fixed route 15 16 public transportation services provided by, or under grant or 17 purchase of service contracts of, the Commuter Rail Board shall be provided without charge to all senior citizens of the 18 19 Metropolitan Region aged 65 and older, under such conditions as 20 shall be prescribed by the Commuter Rail Board.".
