Amends the Bingo License and Tax Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning civil penalties for the failure to obtain a license or special provider's permit.

1 AN ACT concerning gaming.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Bingo License and Tax Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 4.2 as follows:
- 6 (230 ILCS 25/4.2) (from Ch. 120, par. 1104.2)
- 7 Sec. 4.2. Any person or organization which provides
- 8 premises for the the conduct of bingo without first obtaining a
- 9 license or a special provider's permit to do so, or having a
- 10 provider's license or a special provider's permit allows
- 11 unlicensed organizations to conduct bingo on his premises, or
- 12 allows any form of illegal gambling to be conducted on the
- premises where bingo is being played shall, in addition to
- other penalties provided, be subject to a civil penalty of
- 15 \$5,000.
