SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2310/2310-371.5

was 20 ILCS 2310/371

Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that the Department of Public Health has the power to make matching grants from the Heartsaver AED Fund to (i) any school, college, or university (instead of any public school, college, or university); (ii) any public park district; or (iii) any municipal recreation department, to assist in the purchase of an Automated External Defibrillator. Removes the requirement that the entity be "required to have" an AED to be eligible for the grant. Provides that any entity applying for a grant shall not receive more than one grant from the Heartsaver AED Fund each fiscal year (instead of per facility). Makes other changes. Effective immediately.

Sec. 2310-371.5 371. Heartsaver AED Fund; grants. Subject 8 9 to appropriation, the Department of Public Health has the power to make matching grants from the Heartsaver AED Fund, a special 10 fund created in the State treasury, to any school in the State 11 public school, public park district, municipal recreation 12 department, public college, or public university to assist in 13 14 the purchase of required to have an Automated External 15 Defibrillator pursuant to the Physical Fitness Facility 16 Medical Emergency Preparedness Act (Colleen O'Sullivan Law). 17 Applicants for AED grants must demonstrate that they have funds to pay 50% of the cost of the AEDs AED's for which matching 18 19 grant moneys are sought. Any school, public park district, municipal recreation department, college, or university 20 21 applying for the grant shall not receive more than one grant 22 from the Heartsaver AED Fund each fiscal year. Matching grants authorized under this Section shall be limited to one AED per 23

eligible physical fitness facility. The State Treasurer shall accept and deposit into the Fund all gifts, grants, transfers, appropriations, and other amounts from any legal source, public or private, that are designated for deposit into the Fund.
