- 7 Sec. 45-57. Veteran-owned businesses.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section:
- 9 (1) "Armed forces" means the United States Army, Navy,

 10 Marine Corps, Air Force, and Coast Guard.
 - (2) "Veteran" means a person who served in the United States armed forces, a reserve component of the United States armed forces, or the Illinois National Guard and who was discharged (i) honorably, (ii) due to hardship, or (iii) due to a service-connected disability.
 - (i) at least 51% of which is owned by one or more veterans or, in the case of a corporation, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans and (ii) the management and daily business operations of which are conducted by one or more veterans.
- 22 <u>(b) At least 12% of the total dollar amount of State</u> 23 contracts of all agencies under his or her jurisdiction shall

- 1 be established by each chief procurement officer as a goal to 2 be awarded to veteran-owned businesses. This requirement relates to the total dollar amount of State contracts during 3 4 each State fiscal year, calculated by examining independently 5 each type of contract for each State agency that awards those 6 contracts. Only that percentage of agreements that represent the participation of veteran-owned businesses on such 7 8 contracts shall be included.
