AN ACT concerning wildlife.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
2.10 as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/2.10) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.10)

7 Sec. 2.10. The Department may, on an annual basis, establish a spring wild turkey open season within the period 8 9 beginning on March 1 and running through June 30 May 31, and a 10 fall wild turkey season within the period beginning on 11 September October 1 and running through January 31. It shall be unlawful for any person to take wild turkey without possessing 12 a valid "Wild Turkey Hunting Permit". Persons holding a spring 13 14 permit may take female wild turkeys with visible beards or male wild turkeys during the spring open season. Persons holding a 15 fall permit may take turkeys of either sex during the fall open 16 17 season. The Department shall cause notice of administrative rules setting forth the prescribed rules and regulations, 18 19 including those counties of the State where open seasons are 20 established, to be given in accordance with Sections 1.3 and 21 1.13.
