AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1496, AS AMENDED, 2 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No. 3 2, on page 5, immediately below line 12, by inserting the 4 5 following: "(g) The State may cancel a Management and Concession 6 7 Agreement if the Concessionaire, or any executive employee 8 of the Concessionaire, is found quilty of any criminal offense related to the conduct of its business or the 9 regulation thereof in any jurisdiction. An executive 10 11 employee shall be defined as the President, Chairman, Chief 12 Executive Officer, or other employee with executive 13 decision-making authority over the long-term and 14 day-to-day affairs of the Concessionaire, or an employee whose compensation is determined directly, in whole or in 15

part, by the award of or payment pursuant to the Management
