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1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1560

2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1560, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 1, on page 3, by replacing lines 19 through 24 with the 5 following: "(a) A group or individual policy of accident and health 6 7 insurance or managed care plan amended, delivered, issued, or 8 renewed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 9 95th General Assembly must provide coverage and reimbursement when documentation is presented demonstrating a medical 10 necessity and treatment plan for amino acid-based elemental 11 12 formulas, regardless of delivery method, for the diagnosis and treatment of (i) an individual with multiple food allergies or 13 14 intolerances making amino acid-based elemental formulas a medically necessary treatment, (ii) eosinophilic disorders, 15 and (iii) short bowel syndrome, when the prescribing physician 16 17 or dietician has issued a written order stating that the amino

acid-based elemental formula is medically necessary for the

- 1 treatment of a disease or disorder."; and
- 2 on page 4, by deleting lines 1 through 19; and
- 3 on page 14, by replacing lines 6 through 25 with the following:
- "The Department of Healthcare and Family Services must 4
- provide coverage and reimbursement when documentation is 5
- presented demonstrating a medical necessity and treatment plan 6
- 7 for amino acid-based elemental formulas, regardless of
- 8 delivery method, for the diagnosis and treatment of (i) an
- individual with multiple food allergies or intolerances making 9
- 10 amino acid-based elemental formulas a medically necessary
- treatment, (ii) eosinophilic disorders, and (iii) short bowel 11
- 12 syndrome, when the prescribing physician or dietician has
- 13 issued a written order stating that the amino acid-based
- 14 elemental formula is medically necessary for the treatment of a
- disease or disorder.". 15
