1 AN ACT concerning liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by
- 5 changing Section 6-14 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/6-14) (from Ch. 43, par. 129)
- 7 Sec. 6-14. No person shall sell at retail any alcoholic
- 8 liquor on Sundays unless authorized by general ordinance or
- 9 resolution of $\underline{\text{the}}$ the city council, president and board of
- 10 trustees or county board, as the case may be; provided, however
- 11 that the city council, president and board of trustees or
- 12 county board, as the case may be, may further restrict the
- permissible hours for the sale of alcoholic liquors under such
- 14 licenses in its political subdivision as the public good and
- 15 convenience may require.
