SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3948/65 new 20 ILCS 3948/70 new

Amends the Illinois Global Partnership Act. Prohibits IGP officers and employees and their spouses and immediate family from (i) having IGP grants or contracts or specified levels of interests in IGP grants and contracts, (ii) soliciting or accepting gifts from IGP grantees and contractors, and (iii) having IGP travel expenses paid for or reimbursed by IGP grantees or contractors. Requires IGP to develop 2-year goals and strategic plans; requires that IGP annually file the plan and a report of its progress with the Governor and General Assembly, beginning April 1, 2009.

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2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Global Partnership Act is amended
 by adding Sections 65 and 70 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3948/65 new)

7 <u>Sec. 65. Conflicts of interests.</u>

- 8 <u>(a) None of the following shall have or acquire a grant</u> 9 <u>from IGP, a contract for goods or services with IGP, or a</u> 10 <u>direct interest in an IGP grant or IGP contract for goods or</u> 11 <u>services: (i) a member of the IGP board of directors; (ii) the</u> 12 <u>IGP executive director; (iii) an IGP employee; or (iv) the</u> 13 <u>spouse of or immediate family residing with a person described</u> 14 <u>in item (i), (ii), or (iii).</u>
- For the purposes of this subsection, a "direct interest" is the right or potential right to receive (1) more than 5% of the distributive income or ownership share of an IGP grantee or contractor or (2) in combination with a person described in items (i) through (iv) of this subsection, more than 7% of the distributive income or ownership share of an IGP grantee or contractor.

22 (b) None of the following shall solicit or accept a gift 23 from a person or entity that has an IGP grant or that has a
