AN ACT concerning advisory referenda.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
9-1 and by adding Section 9-1.2 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/9-1) (from Ch. 122, par. 9-1)

Sec. 9-1. Scope of article. All school elections shall be
governed by the general election law of the State, except as
otherwise provided in Section 9-1.2.

11 (105 ILCS 5/9-1.2 new) Sec. 9-1.2. Advisory referenda. By a vote of the majority 12 13 of the members of the school board, the board may authorize an advisory question of public policy to be placed on the ballot 14 at the next regularly scheduled election in the school 15 16 district. The school board shall certify the question to the 17 proper election authority, which must submit the question at an 18 election in accordance with the Election Code.
