- 12 Sec. 9-1.2. Advisory referenda. By a vote of the majority
- of the members of the school board, the board may authorize an
- 14 <u>advisory question of public policy to be placed on the ballot</u>
- 15 at the next regularly scheduled election in the school
- district. The school board shall certify the question to the
- proper election authority, which must submit the question at an
- 18 election in accordance with the Election Code.
