The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing Section 32-5 and by adding Section 10-5.1 5 as 6 follows:"; and 7 on page 5, by inserting immediately below line 17 the following: 8 9 "(720 ILCS 5/32-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 32-5) 10 Sec. 32-5. False personation of attorney, judicial, or governmental officials. 11 (a) A person who falsely represents himself or herself to 12 13 be an attorney authorized to practice law for purposes of compensation or consideration commits a Class 4 felony. This 14 15 subsection (a) does not apply to a person who unintentionally

fails to pay attorney registration fees established by Supreme

- 1 Court Rule.
- (b) A person who falsely represents himself or herself to 2
- be a public officer or a public employee or an official or 3
- 4 employee of the federal government commits a Class B
- 5 misdemeanor.
- (c) A person who falsely represents himself or herself to 6
- 7 be a public officer or a public employee commits a Class 4
- felony if that false representation was for the purpose of 8
- 9 effectuating identity theft as defined in Section 16G-15 of
- 10 this Code.
