1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Volunteer Driver Protection Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act:
- 7 "Vehicle insurance" has the same meaning ascribed to it in
- 8 the Illinois Insurance Code.
- 9 "Volunteer driver" means a person who transports
- 10 individuals or goods without compensation above reimbursement
- 11 for expenses. Such volunteer driving must be performed for a
- 12 not-for-profit agency or charitable organization as defined in
- 13 the General Not for Profit Corporation Act of 1986.
- Section 10. Volunteer drivers. An insurer may not refuse to issue vehicle insurance to a person solely because the
- 16 applicant is a volunteer driver. An insurer may not impose a
- 17 surcharge or otherwise increase the rate for a vehicle policy
- solely on the basis that the named insured or any member of the
- insured's household or a person who customarily operates the
- 20 insured's vehicle is a volunteer driver. This Act shall not
- 21 prohibit an insurer from taking any actions upon factors other
- than the volunteer status of the insured driver. No producer of

- vehicle insurance may receive a license under the Illinois 1
- 2 Insurance Code or any other professional regulation statute if
- 3 the producer fails to certify under oath that the producer does
- not discriminate against volunteer drivers.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 5
- 6 becoming law.
