Non-host licensees may carry the host track simulcast program and shall accept wagers on all races included as part 15 of the simulcast program upon which wagering is permitted. <u>All</u> 16 organization licensees shall provide their live signal to all 17 18 advance deposit wagering licensees for a simulcast commission fee not to exceed 6% of the advance deposit wagering licensee's 19 20 Illinois handle on the organization licensee's signal without prior approval by the Board.
