- Sec. 24-3.7. Unlawful transfer of a firearm.
- (a) A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of a 5 firearm when he or she is not eligible to own or possess a
- firearm under State or federal law and sells or gives a firearm 6
- 7 to another person who is not eligible to own or possess a
- 8 firearm under State or federal law and that person who is not
- 9 eligible to own or possess a firearm under State or federal law
- 10 does any of the following acts:
- 11 (1) commits a forcible felony;
- (2) commits an act of armed violence under Article 33A 12
- 13 of this Code; or
- 14 (3) possesses the firearm while in possession of any
- 15 controlled substance.
- (b) Sentence. Unlawful transfer of a firearm is a Class X 16
- 17 felony.".
