Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 7 Sec. 3. Legislative finding. The The General Assembly finds
- 8 that a simplified sales tax and use tax system will reduce and
- 9 over time eliminate the burden and cost for all vendors to
- 10 collect this State's sales and use tax. The General Assembly
- 11 further finds that this State should participate in multistate
- 12 discussions to review or amend or both review and amend the
- terms of the Agreement to simplify and modernize sales tax and
- 14 use tax administration in order to substantially reduce the
- burden of tax compliance for all sellers and for all types of
- 16 commerce.
