2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 2982 by replacing	
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:	
4	"Section 5. The Health Care Justice Act is amended by	
5	adding Section 21 as follows:	
6	(20 ILCS 4045/21 new)	
7	Sec. 21. Legislative Oversight Council on Cost Feasibility	
8	for Health Care Plan Implementation.	
9	(a) The Legislative Oversight Council on Cost Feasibility	
10	for Health Care Plan Implementation is established for the	
11	purpose of examining various health care recommendations made	
12	by entities within the State and improving communication,	
13	accountability, and coordination efforts among the multiple	
14	systems working to strengthen the health care system in this	
15	State.	
16	The Council shall consist of 20 members as follows:	

1	(1) 2 members of the General Assembly and 2 members of
2	the general public appointed by the President of the
3	Senate.
4	(2) 2 members of the General Assembly and 2 members of
5	the general public appointed by the Minority Leader of the
6	Senate.
7	(3) 2 members of the General Assembly and 2 members of
8	the general public appointed by the Speaker of the House of
9	Representatives.
10	(4) 2 members of the General Assembly and 2 members of
11	the general public appointed by the Minority Leader of the
12	House of Representatives.
13	(5) The Director of Healthcare and Family Services or
14	his or her designee.
15	(6) The Secretary of Human Services or his or her
16	<u>designee.</u>
17	(7) The Director of Public Health or his or her
18	<u>designee.</u>
19	(8) The Director of the Division of Insurance of the
20	Department of Financial and Professional Regulation or his
21	or her designee.
22	All appointed members of the Council shall serve in their
23	designated capacities at the pleasure of the designating
24	authority. Members appointed from the general public shall
25	represent the following associations, organizations, and
26	interests: business, labor, insurance, doctors, hospitals, and

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1	nurses.

- (b) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the 2
- 3 House of Representatives shall each designate one member of the
- 4 Council to serve as a co-chair to the Council.
- 5 (c) Council members shall serve without compensation or
- reimbursement for expenses. 6
- (d) The Council shall meet at the call of the 2 co-chairs, 7
- 8 but at least on a quarterly basis.
- 9 (e) The Council may conduct public hearings to gather
- 10 testimony from interested parties regarding health care,
- 11 including changes to existing and proposed programs.
- (f) The Council may advise appropriate State agencies 12
- 13 regarding the establishment of proposed programs or changes to
- 14 existing programs. The State agencies shall take into
- 15 consideration any recommendations made by the Council.
- 16 (q) The Council shall report to the General Assembly and
- the Governor annually, or as it deems necessary, regarding 17
- proposed or recommended changes to State-implemented health 18
- 19 care plans and any associated costs of those changes.
- 20 (h) The Department of Public Health shall provide staff and
- 21 administrative support to the Council.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22
- 23 becoming law.".
