AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing Section
30-140 as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/30-140)

7 30-140. Regulation of certain occupations. Sec. In counties with a population of less than 3,000,000, the the 8 9 electors may regulate hawkers, peddlers, pawnbrokers, itinerant merchants, and transient vendors of merchandise. The 10 township board in those counties may require that any such 11 person register his or her name and the name of any firm he or 12 she represents with the township clerk and may make reasonable 13 14 restrictions of the hours during which he or she may engage in door-to-door solicitation. The township board in 15 those 16 counties also may prohibit the activities of any categories of 17 persons as it determines to be in the best interest of township residents. Any regulation under this Section shall not apply 18 19 within the boundaries of a city, village, or incorporated town. 20 (Source: P.A. 84-822; 88-62.)
