AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The sum of \$150,000, or so much of that amount 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services for 6 the purpose of making a grant to the Arc of Illinois for 7 Family to Family Health Information 8 operating the and Education Center, a toll-free and web-based resource and 9 referral network for families of children and youth with 10 11 special health care needs.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2007.
