2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Critical Health Problems and Comprehensive
Health Education Act is amended by changing Section 3 as
follows:

8 Sec. 3. Comprehensive Health Education Program. The 9 program established under this Act shall include, but not be limited to, the following major educational areas as a basis 10 for curricula in all elementary and secondary schools in this 11 12 State: human ecology and health, human growth and development, the emotional, psychological, physiological, hygienic and 13 14 social responsibilities of family life, including sexual abstinence until marriage, prevention and control of disease, 15 including instruction in grades 6 through 12 on the prevention, 16 transmission and spread of AIDS, sexual assault awareness in 17 secondary schools, public and environmental health, consumer 18 19 health, safety education and disaster survival, mental health and illness, personal health habits, alcohol, drug use, and 20 21 abuse including the medical and legal ramifications of alcohol, 22 drug, and tobacco use, abuse during pregnancy, sexual abstinence until marriage, tobacco, nutrition, and dental 23

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health. The program shall also provide course material and 1 2 instruction to advise pupils of the Abandoned Newborn Infant Protection Act. Notwithstanding the above educational areas, 3 the following areas may also be included as a basis for 4 5 curricula in all elementary and secondary schools in this State: basic first aid (including, but not limited to, 6 7 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver), 8 early prevention and detection of cancer, heart disease, 9 diabetes, stroke, and the prevention of child abuse, neglect, 10 and suicide. The school board of each public elementary and 11 secondary school in the State shall encourage all teachers and 12 other school personnel to acquire, develop, and maintain the 13 skills necessary to properly administer knowledge and life-saving techniques, including without 14 limitation the 15 Heimlich maneuver and rescue breathing. The training shall be 16 in accordance with standards of the American Red Cross, the 17 American Heart Association, or another nationally recognized certifying organization. A school board may use the services of 18 19 non-governmental entities whose personnel have expertise in 20 life-saving techniques to instruct teachers and other school personnel in these techniques. Each school board is encouraged 21 22 to have in its employ, or on its volunteer staff, at least one 23 person who is certified, by the American Red Cross or by 24 another qualified certifying agency, as qualified to 25 administer first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation. In addition, each school board is authorized to allocate 26

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appropriate portions of its institute or inservice days to 1 2 conduct training programs for teachers and other school personnel who have expressed an interest in becoming qualified 3 administer emergency first aid or cardiopulmonary 4 to 5 resuscitation. School boards are urged to encourage their 6 teachers and other school personnel who coach school athletic 7 and other extracurricular school activities to programs 8 acquire, develop, and maintain the knowledge and skills 9 necessary to properly administer first aid and cardiopulmonary 10 resuscitation in accordance with standards and requirements 11 established by the American Red Cross or another qualified 12 certifying agency. No pupil shall be required to take or 13 participate in any class or course on AIDS or family life instruction if his parent or quardian submits written objection 14 15 thereto, and refusal to take or participate in the course or 16 program shall not be reason for suspension or expulsion of the 17 pupil.

18 under Curricula developed programs established in accordance with this Act in the major educational area of 19 20 alcohol and drug use and abuse shall include classroom instruction in grades 5 through 12. The instruction, which 21 22 shall include matters relating to both the physical and legal 23 effects and ramifications of drug and substance abuse, shall be integrated into existing curricula; and the State Board of 24 25 Education shall develop and make available to all elementary 26 and secondary schools in this State instructional materials and

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guidelines which will assist the schools in incorporating the instruction into their existing curricula. In addition, school districts may offer, as part of existing curricula during the school day or as part of an after school program, support services and instruction for pupils or pupils whose parent, parents, or guardians are chemically dependent.
