# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

8 Section 10. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller 10 from the Comptroller's Administrative Fund for the discharge 11 of duties of the office.

12 Section 15. The amount of \$50,300, or so much thereof as 13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller 14 from the State Lottery Fund for expenses in connection with 15 the State Lottery.

16 Section 20. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller 18 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses for the Office 19 of Inspector General.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller HB3777 -5- LRB095 09610 BDD 33222 b 1 for expenses and the administration of Section 15-125 of the 2 Pension Code.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,4 2007.
