1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the State Employees'
9 Retirement System:

8 Section 10. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
9 to the State Employees' Retirement System pursuant to
10 continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions
11 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the
12 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State
13 Employees' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of
14 Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance",
15 approved June 10, 1919, as amended.

16 Section 15. The sum of \$35,236,800, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement
19 System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.

20 Section 20. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
21 to the Judges' Retirement System pursuant to continuing
22 appropriation authorized by the State Pensions Fund

1 Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State
2 Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges'
3 Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12
4 of "An Act in relation to State finance", approved June 10,
5 1919, as amended.

6 Section 25. The sum of \$5,220,300, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly
9 Retirement System for the State's Contribution, as provided
10 by law.

11 Section 30. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
12 to the General Assembly Retirement System pursuant to
13 continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions
14 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the
15 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General
16 Assembly Retirement System, pursuant to the provisions of
17 Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance",
18 approved June 10, 1919, as amended.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
20 2007.
