24 ARTICLE 5

Section 5. The amount of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof 1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the 2 3 Tobacco Settlement Recovery Fund to the Department Healthcare and Family Services in order for the department to 5 provide one-time catastrophic relief payments to Illinois based hospitals that have an MIUR greater than the current 6 statewide mean; are not a publicly owned hospital; and are 7 not part of a multiple hospital network, unless such a 8 hospital has an MIUR greater than the current statewide mean 9 10 plus two standard deviations. Payments under this program will be determined by the Department of Healthcare and Family 11 Services. 12

ARTICLE 99 13

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law. 15
