AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. In addition to any amounts previously appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$6,620,000, or so 5 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from 6 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services 7 to fund a full 3% cost-of-doing-business increase to services 8 provided under the Division of Alcohol and Substance Abuse, 9 to be paid to those services in the State fiscal year 10 beginning July 1, 2007. 11

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2007.
