- AN ACT concerning transportation, which may be referred to as Shib's Law.
- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:
- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding

 Section 11-213 as follows:
- 7 (625 ILCS 5/11-213 new)
- 8 Sec. 11-213. Power of a fire department officer; highway or 9 lane closure. In the absence of a law enforcement officer or a 10 representative of the highway agency having jurisdiction over the highway, an officer of a fire department, in the 11 12 performance of his or her official duties, has the authority to close to traffic a highway, or a lane or lanes of a highway, as 13 14 necessary to protect the safety of persons or property. In order to promote the safe implementation of this Section, the 15 fire department officer shall utilize an official fire 16 17 department vehicle with lighted red or white oscillating, rotating, or flashing lights in accordance with subsection 18 19 (a) (2-4) of Section 12-215 of this Code and proper temporary 20 traffic control in accordance with the sections of the Illinois 21 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices concerning temporary 22 traffic control and incident management. The officer should also receive training in safe practices for accomplishing these 23

- tasks near traffic. This Section shall not apply to highways 1
- 2 under the jurisdiction of the Illinois State Toll Highway
- Authority. The term "highway" shall have the meaning defined by 3
- Section 1-126 of this Code. 4
