### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 430/5-20

Amends the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act. Prohibits a public service announcement on behalf of a State administered program that contains the proper name, image, or voice of a State executive branch constitutional officer or legislator from being displayed on a billboard or electronic message board. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Officials and Employees Ethics Act is
amended by changing Section 5-20 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 430/5-20)

Sec. 5-20. Public service announcements; other promotionalmaterial.

9 Beginning January 1, 2004, no public service (a) announcement or advertisement that is on behalf of any State 10 administered program and contains the proper name, image, or 11 voice of any executive branch constitutional officer or member 12 13 of the General Assembly shall be (i) broadcast or aired on 14 radio or television, (ii) or printed in a commercial newspaper or a commercial magazine, or (iii) displayed on a billboard or 15 16 electronic message board at any time.

(b) The proper name or image of any executive branch constitutional officer or member of the General Assembly may not appear on any (i) bumper stickers, (ii) commercial billboards, (iii) lapel pins or buttons, (iv) magnets, (v) stickers, and (vi) other similar promotional items, that are not in furtherance of the person's official State duties or governmental and public service functions, if designed, paid HB4416 - 2 - LRB095 16574 JAM 42605 b

1 for, prepared, or distributed using public dollars. This 2 subsection does not apply to stocks of items existing on the 3 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 93rd General 4 Assembly.

5 (c) This Section does not apply to communications funded 6 through expenditures required to be reported under Article 9 of 7 the Election Code.
