SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/8-205.5 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that notwithstanding any other provision of the Act or any other law to the contrary, a public utility that, on December 31, 2005, served at least 100,000 electric customers in Illinois may not terminate electric service to a residential customer for nonpayment prior to December 1, 2008. Effective immediately.

- 8 2008. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any

- 11 Illinois may not terminate electric service to a residential
- customer for nonpayment prior to December 1, 2008.
