## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/45-57 new

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. In awarding contracts, requires that a preference, not to exceed 10%, be given to a bidder or offeror that spends a specified amount on health insurance premiums for its employees.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by adding Section 45-57 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/45-57 new)
- Sec. 45-57. Employer health insurance. In awarding contracts, a preference shall be given to a bidder or offeror who provides health insurance for its employees. The preference shall be a reduction in the bid or offer in an amount equal to 1% of the bid or offer for each \$1,000,000 spent on employee health insurance premiums by the bidder or offeror in the 12 months preceding the month the bid or offer is submitted, but
- in no case shall the preference exceed 10%.
