- 16 the energy or other operating costs of the community college
- 17 district. The board may ask for the assistance of any State
- 18 agency, including without limitation the State Board, the
- 19 Illinois Power Agency, or the Environmental Protection Agency,
- 20 in obtaining financing options for a wind generation turbine
- 21 farm.
