Illinois Controlled Substances Act, felony violations of the 1 2 Cannabis Control Act, or felony violations of the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act and 3 4 conspiracies related thereto, no part of the contents of the 5 communication and no evidence derived therefrom may be received in evidence in any trial, hearing, or other proceeding in or 6 before any court, grand jury, department, officer, agency, 7 regulatory body, legislative committee, or other authority of 8 9 this State, or a political subdivision thereof, if the 10 disclosure of that information would be in violation of this subtitle unless the violation involves a forcible felony. 11 Furthermore, the Director of the State Police shall issue rules 12 13 as are necessary concerning the use of devices, review of recordings, notice to parties, retention of recording media, 14 15 and reports regarding their use; and".
